The aim of the training course is to provide leadership skills for today's diverse world. We will be asking participants:

- To reflect on their personal leadership style, values, attitudes and skills in relation to leading in a diverse world.
- To gain a better understanding of working with gender and how to include people with different cultural backgrounds in your team.
- To exchange with other participants the challenges arising from diversity in your own environment and to build a network of exchange.
- To benefit from new knowledge and ideas on how to be more inclusive in their leadership role.
- To return home with new knowledge and ideas on how to be more inclusive in their leadership role with young people
- You will learn more about the funding possibilities of the Erasmus+ programme and a chance to network with European partners.

- ∅ The training will take place in Brittany (France). Accommodation will be either in St. Malo or Sables d'or les pins. St. Malo is a city on the coast, Sables d'or les pins a beautiful sea area on the sea.
- ∅ Only apply if you are excited, interested and willing to work hard at the training. You will be challenged to take risks and go deep into issues.

Travel options to get to the venue:

Currently we are choosing between two venues, which we will share with the participants as soon as it is decided: one is in Saint Malo, the other one in Sables d'Or.

To get to both of them, you have to use the same means of transport. So we advise you to book your flight, either up to Paris, to Rennes or to Dinard airport.

Dinard has its own airport hosting Ryanair flights to and from the UK. It is also a hub for many other European destinations. Worth to check <http://www.dinard.aeroport.fr/en>

Other airports are Paris (Charles de Gaulle or Orly) or Rennes. From there you need to take trains to Rennes (it is around 4-5h from Paris and 2h from Rennes without changes).

We advise you to look at the airport websites as well as railways website-<http://www.voyages-sncf.com> - as connections and timetable may change.

Then from Rennes, we will tell you which way to take to reach us in few days from now. We would advise you to book your train ticket also 1 or 2 months before your arrival because, the prices of the places in train are increasing by the time, if you take it at last minute, you will have a very expensive price.
